- **3. REPORT:** President Little report on SEDD's progress toward target goals for 2023, the May 15, 2023 deadline for Ethics filings, and contacts with absentee commissioners.

The budget projects Hotel Motel Tax income of 120,000. It projects using \$165,055 of fund balance revenues along with hotel/tax receipts to fund total expenditures \$285,000 on SEDD's Southside Projects in 2023-24.
