Approval of Minutes

1. **Action:** Consider \$5,000 Sponsorship of the Ms. Ellen Hill's next event: Home in Monroe 2026 Housing Fair & Expo in June.
2. **Action: Lawn Care Services Procurement:** consider a resolution authorizing the President or her designee to advertise for quotes for lawn maintenance services at 1711 Arizona Street and to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
3. **Action: Proposed 2026 - 2027 Financial Budget:** Consider a resolution authorizing the development and preparation of the proposed operating budget for the 2026-2027 fiscal year.

4. **Action: 1711 Arizona Facility Completion Ad Hoc Committee:** Consider a resolution authorizing the President to appoint an ad hoc committee to review and recommend the final phases required to complete the 1711 Arizona facility, including equipment procurement, interior furnishings, and the construction of a parking lot.
5. **Action: Bylaws Revision Ad Hoc Committee:** Consider a resolution authorizing the President to appoint an ad hoc committee to review, update, and recommend final revisions to the SEDD bylaws for official adoption, including but not limited to changing the number of members of the Board to an odd number instead of an even number.
6. **Action: Seek additional funding for 2025 - 2026:** Consider a resolution requesting additional consideration from the City of Monroe to acquire an addition \$100,000 in 2026-2027 that the SEDD was not able to receive in the 2025-2026 funding cycle because the City's April 28, 2026, cancel meeting was canceled for lack of a quorum. The additional funds would be used to pay for detailed studies for planned SEDD projects in districts 3, 4 and 5.
